Murray Arts presents Billet Doux; an open entry contemporary, non-acquisitive, art prize and exhibition of small scale artworks. All artists who reside in the Murray Arts footprint (AlburyCity, City of Wodonga, Federation Council, Greater Hume Council, Indigo Shire and Towong Shire) and at all stages of their career are encouraged to enter. We aim to showcase the awe-inspiring diversity of our regions dynamic artistic visual arts community.

All eligible entries will be on exhibition at the LibraryMuseum Albury from 29 September - 2 of December 2018.

ELIGIBILITY

- Artwork/s will only be accepted from artists who reside in AlburyCity, City of Wodonga, Federation Council, Greater Hume Shire, Indigo Shire and Towong Shire.
- Artists can enter up to four (4) artworks.
- The artwork/s must have been completed in 2018.
- All entries must measure 8 x 10 inches (20.32 x 25.5cm). This includes any framing.
- Only 2-dimensional artwork that can be attached to the wall will be accepted. All works on paper not framed will be pinned to the wall. We recommend adding tabs to your work to prevent holes. No sculpture or video work will be accepted.
- The artwork/s must be available for exhibition from Tuesday 25 September – Sunday 2 December 2018.
- By entering, you are confirming that you are the creator and owner of the entered artwork/s.
- The winning artwork/s will be licenced by Murray Arts for digital reproduction and possible physical reproduction (for promotional purposes and non-commercial purposes only).
- This is a non-acquisitive prize, so all winning artworks will still be available for purchase

throughout the exhibition.

Murray Arts reserves the right to refuse to display artwork/s if:

- The artwork/s is not, in their opinion of sufficient artistic merit, technical and formal resolution.
- The artwork/s is not 8 x 10 inches in size (including framing).
- The artwork/s poses a safety risk.
- The artwork/s which under normally accepted standards, could be considered to be offensive in terms of pornographic content, character denigration, racial or religious prejudice.

ENTRY

Entries close Friday 21 September 2018.

All artwork/s for Billet Doux must be entered via an entry form.

This CRUCIAL step will assist Murray Arts in the management and delivery of the program. It will also assist in the delivery of a program and payment logistics.

Entries for Billet Doux must be submitted prior to, or at the time of delivery of the artwork/s.

One entry form per artwork.

Works will be returned by post only if a pre-paid return post envelope or package is included. Unsold works to be returned via post, will be returned within 14-21 days after the

completion of the exhibition.

SALES

- All Artwork/s must be for sale.
- The price of the artwork/s must be set by the artist.
- All sales attract a 20% + GST sale commission to Murray Arts.
For example, a \$100 sale will attract a commission of \$22 (\$20 + \$2GST).
Artist will receive \$78 and Murray Arts will receive \$22.
- Upon completion of the exhibition Murray Arts will inform artists via email if their work has sold. All payments to artists for sold work will be made after the completion of the exhibition and via Direct Debit. Please invoice Murray Arts and include all relevant information to allow for prompt payment.

COLLECTION OF ARTWORK/S

All unsold artwork/s MUST be collected from Murray Arts between 4 – 11 December 2018.

JUDGING

- Judges will select up to four (4) artworks to be awarded a \$250 cash prize.
- Prizes will be announced at the opening night. Date To Be Confirmed.
- The People's Choice Award will be announced at the end of the exhibition in the December edition of the Murray Arts Monthly Newsletter. [Click here to subscribe.](#)
- At the time of publishing this document, the Billet Doux 2018 judges are To Be Confirmed.

HANDLING

- All artworks will be handled by experienced staff. However, Murray Arts will not be held responsible for any loss or damage caused to the work while in transit to and from the gallery.
- All care will be taken to ensure the security of the artworks, however the Library/Museum and Murray Arts will not be held responsible for theft or damage of artwork/s during the exhibition.

IMAGE REPRODUCTION

- Entrants agree to allow Murray Arts to reproduce (at no charge) entered artwork/s in all publicity and promotion of Billet Doux, subject to Murray Art's discretion. This does not affect the copyright status of the work.
